Q: How long are the activities?

A: Morning workshops are each one hour. You can schedule students to be with us instead of related arts classes. The afternoon school-wide performance is about 40 minutes.

Q: How much space do you need?

A: We set up 10 feet from a wall if we are on the floor or we can work on stage. A gym, multipurpose room or cafetorium is ideal. Students sit on the floor for the workshops and the show so a room with seating attached to the floor doesn't work well.

Q: Is there a possibility you could damage our floor?

A: No. Everything we have is on wheels or has a plastic base.

Q: How expensive are the concessions?

A: Souvenirs range in price from \$1 to \$8 but most things are less than \$5. In the afternoon after lunch Cotton Candy is \$3, Popcorn is \$2 and Juice is \$1.

Q: Do you have nuts in the food?

A: None of our food has any trace of nuts.

Q: What if some children don't bring money?

A: No one should cry at the circus. Therefore, if most students bring money, we will make sure all students up through grade 1 can get something.

Q: Do we have the right kind of power for the RV?

A: Yes you do. We need regular, plain old, power -- the same outlet in which you would plug in a TV. If overnight parking is a concern, we can make other arrangements.

Q: Are there hidden fees? Do we have to meet a quota?

A: There are no hidden fees and no quota. This really is as good as it sounds. Our grant covers everything so you can relax and enjoy providing this opportunity to your student body!
